Dear Grace Family,

Thank you to all of you for your continued prayers for your church family during this time.

COVID-19 has presented unprecedented challenges in every aspect of our lives. The health and well-being our congregational life, mission, and fellowship is certainly no exception.

Because of the continued recommendation to limit gatherings to ten people or less and because many in our congregation fall into a category of increased risk, we will continue to suspend all in person group activities. We will do so until we receive instruction from state and federal authorities that is such gatherings no longer pose an increased risk of illness.

During this time, we will continue to creatively seek to find ways to engage in continued mission and fellowship as a church.

I have been heartened by the strong "attendance" at the daily 3:30 p.m. zoom prayer meeting and Wednesday night bible study. These will continue.

Some of our small groups and ministry teams are also continuing to function using Zoom as well. I am also grateful for the emails and texts I am receiving from many of you telling of how you are reaching out, connecting to, and caring for one another through texts and phone calls.

Each council member has been assigned a number of households to call each week simply to check in, listen, encourage, and learn of needs and concerns of the congregation. I am grateful that our council has warmly embraced this added duty.

Your council has also met via Zoom and is taking seriously our calling to creatively continue the mission of the church during this time.

We will continue to make video and audio recordings of an abbreviated Sunday morning service. Our goal is to have those recordings available on our church website by 1:00 p.m. each Sunday.

We will get through this together and I believe we will be a stronger church because of this experience!


