


# Tidings of Grace

### **Global Mission Thank You!**

Following a 2-year hiatus due to the pandemic, it was great to return to our traditional Lenten soup suppers this year. Your generous offerings over the five weeks totaled \$568.00. *India Transformed!*, our primary global mission beneficiary, and official mission partner of the NALC, is the recipient of these funds and will also receive a 6:1 gift match through the generosity of a handful of dedicated donors (that's \$3,400 total). Since its founding in 1988, the ministry has had a great impact on spiritual and material poverty in India:

5,000+ children cared for and educated

1,800+ women vocationally trained and employed

1,500+ missionaries trained

1,600+ churches established

10,000+ graduates of K-12 Christian school

12 Million people reached with the Gospel

Our individual, group and congregational offerings the past 10 years have directly supported all of the above to one extent or another. Their next endeavor is to expand the continuum of Christian education through college level, to reach young adults who will be future leaders in India. It is toward this goal that our current offering is being applied, to help fund construction of a new Christian college adjacent to the current K-12 school. 
<u>The Administration and Finance Team is looking for at least five volunteers</u> to serve as a Counting Team. The team will consist of a Lead Counter and at least four Rotating Counters. Each week, team members will secure, count, record, and deposit the offerings Grace receives.

The Lead Counter, except for occasional absences, will work every week. Each Rotating Counter will work with the Lead Counter once per month. This arrangement provides security and transparency. It also protects the reputations of the counters.

The Lead Counter will use a computer to record offerings in our database. The Rotating Counters will use a printing calculator and the office copier. All counters will keep information regarding donors and gifts in strict confidence.

We'll provide training and written procedures. We'll provide support until all volunteers are comfortable with their duties. #### \*\*A New Ministry to Men

Dear Grace Family,

Throughout my two decades of ordained ministry, parishioners have occasionally confided to me that they, a spouse, or family member has lapsed into a pornography addiction. Invariably this is spiritually and relationally devastating to those addicted and to those who love them.

While the incidence is significantly lower than in the general population, research shows this issue even affects Christian men who regularly attend worship services.<sup>1</sup>

Secular 12-step groups are available, but I long wished for a biblically based approach to help men find freedom from this spiritual bondage. A few years ago, I was delighted to learn of such a resource, the Conquer Series curriculum. I found Conquer to be biblically sound, and—based on my study of addiction issues during clinical pastoral education—clinically sound as well.

A couple in our church family who have greatly benefited from the husband's participation in Conquer recently inquired if Grace could provide space for a Conquer educational / support group under his leadership. That request initiated a season of prayer, discernment, and deliberation by me and your council.


I announced last Sunday that council voted unanimously to provide a room for a Conquer group at Grace. I also offered to address any questions or concerns in an informational meeting after worship. I will be available again in the Adult Sunday School room for the same purpose after church this Sunday May 1. I am also available to meet confidentially regarding Conquer and pornography addiction issues.

Galatians 6:1 states, "Brothers, if anyone is caught in *any* transgression, you who are spiritual should *restore him in a spirit of gentleness*" (emphasis mine). It is my hope that by hosting a Conquer Series group at Grace we can be agents of restoration for individuals and families in our community. The initial Conquer Group meeting at Grace will be Tuesday, May 10, at 7:00 p.m.
