Let me draw your attention to two important aspects of this schedule.

First, this year's **Lenten vespers services will focus on Luther's Small Catechism**. Each week, a member of Grace will portray Martin Luther explaining one section of the Catechism. I will then offer a few brief comments on that section of the catechism as well. This will reinforce what we have learned on Wednesday evenings from Dr. Nestigen's instructional series on the catechism.

Second, significant changes are planned for our Good Friday service. We will have a **Tenebrae Service** featuring our choir and soloists as we follow Jesus' final steps to the cross. I strongly encourage you to attend this service as I believe it will be one of the highlights of the entire year.

More importantly, I strongly encourage you to personally strengthen your spiritual walk this Lenten season. Perhaps you will want to memorize the small catechism, make use of the Lenten daily devotional available on this Grace website, read through the forty chapters of the book of Exodus, or read and reflect on the twenty-one chapters of the Gospel of John.

Whatever you choose, make the most of these 40 days.
