

Pastor Phil's Recommended Books on Marriage





These are: Enhance your Love Maps, Nurture Your Fondness and Admiration, Turn Toward Each Other, Let Your Partner Influence You, Solve Your Solvable Problems, Overcome Gridlock, and Create Shared Meaning. Sacred Marriage: by Gary Thomas. Written from a biblical perspective, Thomas argues that one of God's primary intentions in marriage is to foster our personal holiness and not merely our personal happiness. Thus, Marriage is a Spiritual Discipline with eternal reward.
